The interior and exterior need to be staged and ready prior to our arrival. in the event your home is not photo ready before the appointment, please arrange for your photo session to be rescheduled by 5pm the day before your session.

Checklist:	Right before your scheduled time make sure:
<ul> <li>□ Roll up hoses</li> <li>□ Set up outdoor furniture – open umbrellas</li> <li>□ Remove trash cans – put them in the garage or by the street as far from the house as possible</li> <li>□ Have the lawn at a presentable level</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>interior lights are on</li> <li>Blinds are open</li> <li>Ceiling fans are off</li> <li>Bulbs are a consistent color</li> <li>Remove cars from the driveway – do not park in front of the house</li> </ul>

Important Tine	

- The laundry room or garage make a great temporary spot for items that you need to quickly make disappear for the shoot. If there is not enough room in those spaces, please hide additional items in closets or under beds.
- Remove seasonal decorations if possible.

REMEMBER: Anything that is in the room will be captured in the photo, so remove anything of value that you do not want visible in photos. The photographer will be happy to walk through the home with you before the shoot; however, they only make light staging suggestions and micro adjustments. Moving items from room to room is not an option while the photographer is there; everything needs to be moved ahead of time.
